Certificate II Spoken and Written English	This certificate is an excellent starting point for the new migrant or to build the confidence of an adult who did not finish high school. It is a pathway to studying Certificate III Spoken and Written English.
Certificate III Spoken and Written English	This certificate builds on the skills of Certificate II and offers the students many opportunities to practice their new skills. It is a pathway to studying Certificate IV Spoken and Written English.
Certificate IV Spoken and Written English	Graduates of this certificate will have achieved the equivalent to completing year 10 with an average of 3.5 or C grade across four learning areas including English.
