Courses	Career Opportunities
Cake Decorating	Provides knowledge, skill and techniques to make and decorate cakes to commercial standard.
Certificate III Hospitality (Operations)	Graduates are qualified to work as: Bar Person; Wait Person; Cashier; Customer Service Officer; Host/ess; Usher.
Certificate III Hospitality Operations (Front Office)	Graduates are qualified to work as a Hotel Receptionist; or within an office environment at a B&B or small accommodation hotel.
Certificate III Hospitality (Commercial Cookery)	Graduates are qualified to work as: Chef; Cook; Executive Chef; Catering Manager; Site Manager.
Certificate IV Hospitality (Supervision)	This certificate trains the graduate to fulfil supervisory roles within the hospitality industry such as: Bar Supervisor; Restaurant Supervisor; Catering Supervisor.
Diploma of Hospitality Management	Graduates of this diploma are qualified to work as: Restaurant Manager; Catering Manager; Purser; Hotel Manager.
Advanced Diploma of Hospitality Management	Graduates of this advanced diploma are qualified to work as: Food and Beverage Managers; Directors; plus all of the above listed positions.

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
